



Gorilla Kleen Explains How Cleaning Method Shapes the Pricing of Pressure Washing

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Gorilla Kleen, a professional pressure washing company serving Sarasota and Manatee counties, has released guidance detailing how the cleaning method selected for a project, and not surface size alone, determines the final cost of exterior cleaning work along the Gulf Coast.

The explanation centers on the difference between two distinct approaches. Soft washing applies specialized solutions at low pressure to treat biological growth such as algae and mold at the root. Standard high-pressure cleaning physically removes buildup by blasting it off the surface. Each method requires different equipment, solutions, and expertise, and each carries different implications for both cost and long-term surface condition.

Soft washing often costs more upfront because it relies on targeted biocides and careful application rather than raw force. That additional investment protects roofing material and siding from the wear that aggressive pressure can inflict over time. High-pressure cleaning can appear less expensive in the moment, but when

applied to delicate surfaces it can carry hidden risk, including damage to shingles, textured concrete, and fragile siding.

The distinction carries particular weight in the region. Gulf Coast humidity accelerates algae and mold growth on homes throughout Sarasota and Manatee counties, which makes cleaning method and frequency more significant considerations locally than in drier climates. Growth that returns quickly after a surface-level cleaning can lead to repeated work, while treating the organism at its root can extend the interval between cleanings.

The company notes that several factors combine to shape any estimate. Square footage, surface material, and the severity of buildup each contribute, and professional pricing reflects the specific combination of method, equipment, and solution a given surface requires rather than square footage on its own. Typical rates in the field range widely depending on these variables, and a delicate roof cleaned by soft washing is evaluated differently from a durable driveway treated with high pressure.

"The Pricing of Pressure Washing is often misunderstood because people assume it comes down to how large an area is," said John McLoud, president of Gorilla Kleen. "In practice, the method matters just as much. Choosing the wrong approach for a surface can cost far more later in repairs than any short-term savings on the cleaning itself."

As part of its process, the company applies EPA-compliant, biodegradable detergents intended to minimize impact on both the treated surface and the surrounding property. That approach reflects an emphasis on matching the solution and pressure level to the material being cleaned.

"A responsible estimate accounts for what a surface can safely withstand," McLoud added. "Evaluating a job means looking at the material, the growth present, and the humidity conditions that drive it, then selecting the method that treats the problem without harming the property."
